

How is disable LLMNR in Windows 7

There have been a number of issues reported with certain software packages that recommend disabling this feature in Windows.


1. Select Start Button and in the Search for programs and files window type gpedit.msc




2. Under Computer Configuration expand Administrative Templates, expand Network and select DNS Client.



3. On the right side of window near bottom center select the Standard tab and double click on Turn off Multicast Name Resolution.



4. Edit and Disable the policy by selecting the Enable button you are turning the default feature off. Select Apply and OK.



- 5. Select the Start Button again and in the Search for programs and files window type CMD.
- 6. In the command window type ipconfig /flushdns
